

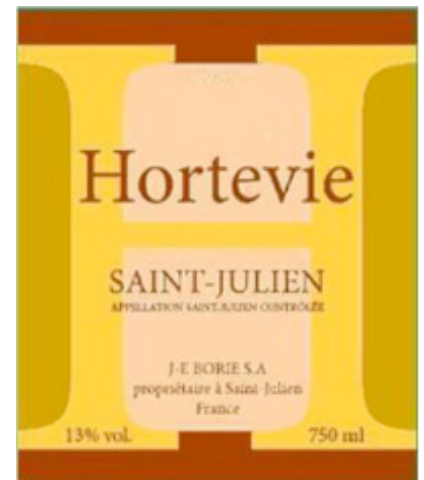


CHATEAU HORTEVIE

ST. JULIEN, BORDEAUX

63% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31% Merlot
3% Petit Verdot, 3% Cabernet Franc



Now owned by Mr. Bruno Borie (since Feb 2006) and made by the Ducru Beaucaillou team, this wine has really improved in quality over the last three years. The 2006 shows great class and depth, perhaps even better than the 2005 vintage in complexity and concentration of fruit. This vintage exhibits sweet black currant and ripe cherry fruit along with notions of herbs, damp earth, and spice box. Sensual and round, it is ideal for drinking over the next 5-6 years.
